The Springfield Municipal Airport is owned and operated by the City of Springfield, supports local businesses and community, and provides a connection to the entire region.



## **GENERAL AVIATION (GA)**

- Self-service fuel is available 24/7 with a credit card
- A paved 3,402 foot runway with GPS and VOR approaches
- Can accommodate aircraft like the King Air or the Cessna Citation models
- 24/7 access to arrival/departure building with pilot lounge, rest area, restrooms and coffee
- Hangar space available for only \$65 a month
- Supports flight training throughout the region
