ORDINANCE NO. 427

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AND REGULATING THE STORAGE AND PARKING OF VEHICLES IN AREAS ZONED SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (R-1), MULTIPLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (R-2), COMMERCIAL (C-1), HIGHWAY COMMERCIAL (C-2), AND INDUSTRIAL (I) IN THE CITY OF SPRINGFIELD, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

The City Council of the City of Springfield does ordain that the City Code shall be amended to include the following sections:

- Section 9.39 On any lot or parcel zoned as Single Family Residential (R-1) or Multiple Family Residential (R-2) which is bounded on two (2) sides by intersecting street or highway rights-of way, no vehicle or recreational device shall be parked within 20 feet of the point of intersection of such street or highway rights-of-way.
- Section 9.40 Sections 9.36, 9.37, 9.38, and 9.39 shall apply to areas zoned Commercial (C-1), Highway Commercial (C-2), and Industrial (I) if those properties are used as a single family residence.

Effective Date: This ordinance becomes effective upon its passage and publication according to law.
